At the conclusion of each days tryouts, players will receive one of three possible evaluations;

1. Selected for placement on a team.

At this time Parents and Players will sign a letter of intent and the initial, non-refundable, deposit is collected.

2. Return for further evaluation.

This option is for players who are just short of meeting the minimum requirements. May also be requested if the parent believes that the player's performance is below their normal/average skill level.

3. Recommend additional training prior to being placed.

If the player does not meet the minimum requirements AND is not expected to be able to meet the requirements prior to the start of the regular season, the player will be asked to return at a later date or be offered a training program.
